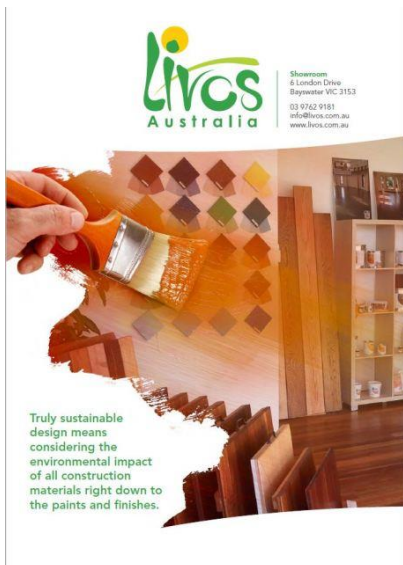
New maintenance kits!

Due to regular requests by DIYers and various professionals, we have put together 2 handy DIY repair/care kits for touching up tired surfaces, repairing minor scratches and long term maintenance.

- One for oiled Table Tops and Benches (this can also be used on Furniture) Product code #2017-2

- One for Floors (which can be used on any floor surface from Timber, Cork or Concrete) Product code #2017-1

They each contain the appropriate oil, a Trena PH Neutral Cleaner (a concentrate), the required sandpaper, a cloth, a green "abrasive" pad and a white "polishing" pad. These care kits are designed to make the process quicker and easier for you.

Tips for using Livos in winter

When using any of the Livos products during winter it is really important to take into consideration the working temperature and "between coat" conditions as these will affect the timeframe and finish you achieve. The Livos oils are like any other coatings...they do not like the cold. Always ensure the oils are brought to a reasonable room temperature before use. Ensuring warmth and ventilation after application will aid in the curing process as well.

It is important to note that the application, penetrating and curing times will need to be adjusted to suite particular climatic conditions. Whilst we understand that optimal temperature is not always possible, for most a slightly reduced temperature with ventilation may still be suitable, we have heard of clients applying the oils in situations of only 3 degrees. It is important to reiterate that, coatings, natural or otherwise do not like the cold and trying to recoat after 24 hours, often leaves the surface still tacky. If a previous layer is tacky no additional oil should be applied, instead additional time, along with added heat or ventilation should be provided.
