With various ply substrates now popular for kitchen cabinets and even benches, so we are receiving increasing requests for information regarding the use of the Kunos counter top oil.

Whilst we have had no issues with the Kunos natural oil sealer # 244 (that we tested several years ago) on ply and similar substrates, we have now also completed testings with the #243. With an overly generous amount of oil and three weeks later, there is absolutely no cupping, separation or delamination of the surface.


