Tips for using Livos in winter

When using any of the Livos products during winter it is really important to take into consideration the working temperature and "between coat" conditions as these will affect the timeframe and finish you achieve. The Livos oils are like other oils and become thicker and more solid with reduced temperatures. Thus making them difficult to apply and less likely to be able to penetrate where they are needed within the timber. Always ensure the oils are brought to a reasonable room temperature before use. Ensuring warmth and ventilation after application will aid in the curing process as well

While 24 hours between coats is usually recommended it is important to note this is under the conditions of 23 degrees. While we understand this is not always possible, and for most a slightly reduced temperature with ventilation this will still be a suitable time frame. However we have heard of clients with conditions of only 3 degrees following the timeframe and trying to recoat after 24 hours, at this point the oil is usually tacky and has not begun to cure at all. If a previous layer is tacky no additional oil should be applied, instead additional time, along with added heat or ventilation should be undertaken.
