Products without Cobalt

Standstill is a step backwards – therefore, Livos Germany regularly research new combinations and possible uses of alternative raw materials in order to remain true to the claim of odour neutrality, surface quality and compatibility.

In order to ensure a uniform curing of LIVOS oils, small quantities of drying agents = metals (for example, calcium, manganese, cobalt) have been successfully used in our products for many years. With new alternatives, we will now completely replace the cobalt dryers. The new drying agents (e.g., manganese = Mn, iron = Fe) can be found in the full declaration of the products. Some products such as the KUNOS Countertop Oil No. 243 have been manufactured without cobalt for some time and as such do not require separate labelling.

Cork truly is a renewable raw material

Cork is becoming popular again due to the material being durable, insulating, soundproof, foot warm and also easy to maintain. Synthetic coatings used when sealing cork tiles often contain many harmful materials that may cause chemically sensitive people to develop allergic reactions or respiratory problems. The optimal solution, and to stay true to the nature of the material would be to obtain untreated cork, then seal the surface with a natural resin hardening oil such as the LIVOS Kunos natural oil sealer. <u>Click here</u> to read the full article.

Mixed bag of weather



With Australia being affected with such a mixed bag of weather conditions in all states, please contact us if you require any clarifications in applications. For example, in times of high humidity, it would be advantageous to allow an extra day in-between coats.

Do not apply the decking oil in full sun or if the temperature is extreme. It will tack off too quickly. Be aware too if applying on floors where the timber is in direct sunlight, remove excess earlier than stated.
