Decanting unused oil

At times one is boarderline with a size tin one needs for a specific project or perhaps one intends to use a specific container over several jobs. As with all products, it is more economical to purchase larger quantities, but not if it "goes off".

Due to the oils not having synthetic preservatives, the oils may form a skin or "go off" with time. The formation of skin occurs because the ingredients react with air.

This can be prevented by on of the following suggestions;

Transferring or decanting into smaller containers. Inserting marbles into the container to raise the level of the oil, works, but it creates a cleaning effort that some customers do not like.

Another idea is Laying a wax paper on the oil surface. That is a very practical and good alternative.
