TINTED GAP-FILLING EPOXY

Boatcraft has released two new tinted versions of its popular Epox-E-Glue. The product has been formulated to meet the requirements of woodworkers seeking a gap-filling thixotropic (won't sag) paste glue coloured to suit the timbers they are working with.

The joint does not need to be clamped and if the mating surfaces are not perfect, the Epox-E-Glue will fill the gaps. The glue will adhere tenaciously to most timbers and will develop 90% of its strength overnight at average working temperatures.
